

Hello Haymaker Families!

We wanted to address the Governor's updated mandate for masks today- Masks are not mandatory in all public spaces in Pennsylvania, Gov Tom Wolf's administration announced Wednesday afternoon. The new order, signed by Secretary of Health Dr. Rachel Levine, takes effect immediately.

The order says individuals are required to wear face coverings if they are:

- Outdoors and unable to consistently maintain a distance of 6 feet from individuals who are not members of their household

Our initial COVID guidelines still remain in effect. Members are asked to please wear masks when they are unable to maintain social distance of 6 feet from non household members.

Examples of this include-

- Checking in at the front desk
- Going to the snack bar
- Using the restroom
- When speaking to the guards

No masks are to be worn in the pool. Masks are not required outside when you are able to maintain a safe social distance (sitting in your pool chair).

Please explain these guidelines to all members of your family, especially if you have teenage children that will be at the pool without adult supervision, the expectation is that they will comply with the rules.

Please help us to keep our employees and families safe and healthy and keep Haymaker off the COVID map!
