#### volunteer incentive

Members will submit a separate \$50 check with their membership fee.
The check will be shredded after the family (16 yo or above) volunteers 4 hours to help open the pool. Note that volunteer hours must be completed by June 30. Checks will be deposited on 6/30 for any families that have not completed their hours.

#### guest fees

Bring a guest to pool for \$5/day.Or purchase a punchcard good for 10 guest passes for the low price of \$40! (limit one punchcard per family). Punchcard valid current season only.

#### swim team

Any child aged 5-18 who can swim a length of the pool can join the team. No knowledge of strokes or team experience necessary! A great way to get better at swimming, have a great time, and it's excellent exercise. New swimmers are welcome to try out the team and see if they like it.
